Carpenter – Surface services

Under the supervision of the Surface Services Supervisor, the Carpenter – Surface Services is responsible for the maintenance, repair, and fabrication of wooden elements, composite materials, or related products for buildings, infrastructures, and surface installations at the mine site.

In this role, he/she works closely with the maintenance, operations, and health & safety teams to ensure the proper functioning of infrastructures and support the site's daily activities.

The primary mission is to maintain safe, functional, and compliant installations while contributing to operational efficiency and ensuring compliance with health and safety requirements.

DUTIES ASSOCIATED WITH RESPONSABILITIES

Maintenance and carpentry work

- ❖ Perform preventive and corrective maintenance of surface structures, buildings, and installations (doors, frames, stairs, platforms, partitions, roofs, etc.).
- ❖ Fabricate, modify, or repair components made of wood, plywood, composite panels, or other construction materials.
- ❖ Install, adjust, and repair doors, windows, locks, moldings, finishes, and other architectural elements.
- ❖ Participate in the construction, setup, or renovation of workspaces, workshops, offices, or operational areas.

Work planning, execution and various manual tasks

- ❖ Read and interpret plans, sketches, specifications, and technical data sheets.
- ❖ Use hand tools, power tools, and specialized equipment (saws, planers, nail guns, drills, etc.) safely and appropriately.
- ❖ Document interventions in maintenance tracking systems.
- ❖ Prepare and clean work areas before and after interventions.
- ❖ Ensure the transport and distribution of materials, tools, and equipment required for work.
- ❖ Support maintenance and construction teams during projects or specific interventions.
- ❖ Assemble and disassemble temporary structures.
- ❖ Perform minor painting, repair, and setup tasks.
- ❖ Load and unload trucks or containers.
- ❖ Perform manual tasks associated with site water pumping.



Health and safety compliance

- ❖ Strictly apply occupational health and safety procedures.
- ❖ Properly use personal protective equipment (PPE).
- ❖ Report any hazardous situation, anomaly or risk condition observed on site.
